### Reconciliation and New Life

“Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts! See if there be any wicked way in me and lead me in the way everlasting.” (Ps. 139:23, 24)

We are capable of wonderfully good actions, but the sad fact of real life is that we all make mistakes. The Church never ceases to remind us of our noble calling to holiness and of Jesus' loving forgiveness. Though we are constantly facing the battle between good and evil, Jesus' words ensure that we do not endure this battle alone, but the Holy Spirit who pours his power and love into our hearts so that we may overcome temptations.

Lent is the season for coming out of the shadows and coming clean. A genuine conversion is not only required us to open our hearts to the priest, recount our failing and ask for forgiveness, but it also involves the willingness to take a new path that has Christ walks with us. Through confession, we are called to seek some understanding of the inner dynamics that caused the behavior so that we can deal with the temptation and it is root cause next time we are faced with it. This level of understanding helps us to become more aware of our hidden motives that lead us to sin.

The sacrament of forgiveness is the Lord's gift to “all who labor and are heavy laden” and to whom he promises rest. “Take my yoke upon you,” Jesus says, “and learn from me, for I am meek and humble of heart; and you will find rest for yourselves. For my yoke is easy, and my burden light” (Matthew 11:28-30). We need God to guide us during the process of reconciliation because God's wisdom helps us to see the behavior clearly, the inner wounds, and sin patterns. Only through sincere confession, the grace of God flows more freely among us so that we experience the ultimate freedom from sin, guilt, and the heavy burden of unresolved pain in our relationships. As we together approach the joy of Easter, may this be a time of interior renewal for each of us and for our parish, a renewal that will be deepened to the extent that we commit ourselves to God's mercy and to the reconciliation that we all desire and need. Amen.
