Reflection for Palm Sunday

Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week, the week of events leading up to Jesus' death. Through his death on the cross, Jesus shows us his infinite love for all humankind. He sacrificed his time, talent and even his life. He teaches us, "There is no greater love than to lay down one's life for one's friends." (John 15:13)

Meditating on the passion of Jesus is an important mission that the Church asks from each one of us during this holy week. The cross is not only a symbol of death, but it is also a symbol of rebirth. Only when we truly understand Jesus' love through his passion and death, we will become more aware of the need to return his love in our Christian life. The process of returning Jesus' love sometimes requires sacrifice.

Love and pain seem opposite each other; however, love and pain are two friends who walk side by side. There is no love without sacrifice and there is no sacrifice without pain. It is a contradiction to say we love Jesus, but we do not want to sacrifice for him. We cannot love Jesus and still want to hold on to our sinfulness.

We are called to believe through death there is life, through darkness there is light. When we are facing sufferings or temptations, the most appropriate attitude is to look up and look at the crucifix and pray to God as Jesus did, "Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done." (Luke 22:42)
